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Letter from The Director...

During the past year, several significant changes occurred at the Community Center:

- 1) The Community Center's child care site located at OPRFHS was closed and the infant and toddler programs were relocated to the River Forest building
- 2) Existing classrooms at the River Forest site were renovated to accommodate the relocation of the infant and toddler classes and the new classrooms were opened for the start of the 2024-2025 school year
- 3) the Illinois Department of Children & Family Services amended the Center's license enabling the Center to operate State licensed programs for infants, toddlers and two year olds in addition to the preschool and school-age programs that have previously been licensed

Additionally, one of the most noteworthy facts about the classroom renovations is they were completed without using tax dollars!! The River Forest Community Center is a self-supporting organization that derives its operating budget from program user fees. Historically, the Community Center was incorporated in 1975 as an Illinois not-for-profit organization with a mission of providing recreational, social and educational programs for residents of River Forest and surrounding communities. The Community Center CANNOT and DOES NOT tax River Forest residents.

Going forward, the Community Center will continue to provide quality programs at a reasonable cost. As always, the Community

Center sincerely appreciates our participants who have remained committed to and shown confidence in our ability to provide quality programs.

In addition to its own programs, the Community Center has also developed a number of key partnerships with other community organizations and agencies to benefit residents and program participants. Each of these partnerships are vital to the overall success of the Community Center and include:

River Forest Township - shared resources, facilities and services for the benefit of residents plus joint sponsorship of numerous programs for youth and senior citizens.

Oak Park/River Forest High School District 200 – shared resources plus hosting the Community Integrated Transition Education (CITE) program for OPRFHS students.

Opportunity Knocks (OK) – expanded programs at the Community Center

River Forest School District 90 - shared resources, facilities and services for residents Participants and visitors are encouraged to check out the Center's web site at www.rfcc.info to view our on-line program brochure and available programs. Half-Day Early Childhood Programs

Parent/Caregiver & Child Programs:

Munchkins (15-23 months by Sept. 1)

Our Munchkins class provides an opportunity for children and their parents/caregivers to spend uninterrupted time together exploring and learning. Activities include free play, art activities, science activities, story time, and music & movement. Class size is limited to 15 participants.

Mon/Wed » 9:00 am-10:00am » \$70.00/month

A \$35 registration fee plus the first month's tuition is due at the time of registration. *Registration fees and deposits are non-refundable.*

Playschool (2 years by Sept. 1)

Playschool for Tots is a unique program suited for children who are not quite ready for a preschool program but have begun to seek a group experience. Activities include free play, art activities, large group time – including songs, stories, finger plays, large motor play, and snack time. This program is designed to help prepare children for preschool. Parents/ caregivers are required to attend with child. Class size is limited to 15 participants.

Half-Day Preschool

Our program follows the Creative Curriculum Approach to Early Learning Education. This play-based curriculum focuses on five fundamental principles of instruction: teacher-child interactions and relationships, social-emotional competence, constructive and purposeful play, interacting with the environment, and building teacher-family partnerships to promote development and learning.

Our teachers use weekly themed activities to incorporate basic language, mathematics, motor, and social skills in a developmentally appropriate manner.

Half-Day Preschool – Three to Five Year Olds

Full-Day Early Childhood Programs

Infants, Toddlers & Two-Year-Olds

Our Infant, Toddler, and Two-Year-Old Program provides a safe, loving, and stimulating environment where your child can grow, explore, and thrive during their most formative years. Activities and interactions are tailored to support each child's individual needs and developmental milestones.

Our full-day program operates Monday–Friday from 7:00am to 6:00pm.

Our full-day preschool program operates Monday–Friday from 7:00am to 6:00pm. Flexible scheduling options are available.

Parents must choose their child's schedule upon registration, and tuition will be based on the child's weekly commitment (a two-day per week minimum is required, with priority given to full-time participants). Daily rates are below.

All children must be 3 years old and toilet trained to start the preschool program.

The program is designed to encourage children to develop the skills needed to begin Kindergarten as determined by our local school districts.

Flexible scheduling options are available.

Parents must choose their child's schedule upon registration, and tuition will be based on the child's weekly commitment (a two-day per week minimum is required, with priority given to full-time participants). Daily rates are below.

All children must be 4 years old and toilet trained to start our pre-kindergarten program.

Before & After School Programs with TRANSPORTATION:

Kinder City/After School Adventurers

Before and after school care is available for children in Kindergarten and 1st grade. Children will be actively involved in art, science, cooking, and large motor activities. Our full time program is very flexible —parents may choose their own schedule (i.e.: A child may attend Monday, Tuesday, and Friday for 6 or more hours per day.) However, parents must commit to their chosen schedule throughout the school year. A deposit of your child's full weekly commitment is due upon registration.
